### Session Highlights

#### CARES Act Funding, Accounting & Reporting

This session discusses the eligible and ineligible costs that are permitted with the supplemental funds recently provided by HUD to pay for COVID-19 and operational expenses. We will review the new flexibilities and waivers HUD is providing to administer the LIPH and HCV programs through recent PIH Notices. Capital Funds will be examined with respect to certain costs that will be permitted, as well as the BLI limitations that have been relaxed. We will also examine the period of performance and reporting requirements for the supplemental funds and record retention.

#### Got Equity? Creating a Framework of Equity and Inclusion for NAHRO

In this session, Liz Glenn, Chair of NAHRO's Diversity Equity and Inclusion Advisory Committee, will deliver a presentation on the work of the advisory committee.
